POLICY BCEA NOMINATION TO COMMITTEES

The South Slave Divisional Education Council is empowered to appoint a representative to other Councils and Committees. This representative would act on behalf of the South Slave Divisional Education Council

In addition, the South Slave Divisional Education Council is empowered to appoint representatives to sub-committees established by the Council.

REGULATIONS

- The Chairperson will be the designate by default for all requests by the Minister or otherwise for participation at Chairpersons' and other special meetings. The vice-chairperson will attend if the Chairperson is unavailable.
- Requests for a representative of the South Slave Divisional Council to serve on outside boards, committees and agencies will be presented to the Council. Where a Council member is not chosen the Council may choose to solicit names from the DEAs for consideration and a representative will be selected from the names put forward.

Sub-committee representation

- The Finance Committee will be a committee of the whole, with the Superintendent and Comptroller.
- Two members of Council, along with two members of administration, will serve on all other sub-committees established by Council.
- The Council Chairperson will serve on all sub-committees as an ex-officio member.
- Members will be asked to volunteer to serve on the sub-committees. Where insufficient Council representation is evident, the Chairperson may appoint members to serve on the sub-committee. Where more than two members of Council wish to serve on one sub-committee, the Chairperson may call a vote by secret ballot.
