POLICY BFE ADMINISTRATION IN LIEU OF COUNCIL POLICY

Where immediate action is required and no Council policy exists, the Superintendent is authorized to act in accordance with the best-established practice.

In doing so, the Superintendent shall use as a guide the following:

- 1. The action is legal.
- 2. The action is in keeping with the Council's educational philosophy.
- 3. The action reflects the best-established educational or managerial practice appropriate to the given situation.
- 4. In the opinion of the Superintendent, the action appears to be in the best interests of the South Slave Divisional Education Council.
- 5. The Superintendent will consult with the chairperson or designate.
